

- 1) Open Terminal
- 2) Type “ssh [kerb]@athena.dialup.mit.edu”; Enter
- 3) Type “[password]”; Enter
- 4) Type “attach ensemble”; Enter
- 5) Type “cd /mit/ensemble”; Enter
- 6) Type “ls”; Enter
- 7) Type “cd web\_scripts/about”; Enter
- 8) Type “ls”; Enter
- 9) Type “cp constitution.php old\_constitution/constitution\_[yyyy]\_[mm]\_[dd].php”;  
Enter
- 10) Type “vi constitution.php”; Enter (pulls up the constitution in Vim)
- 11) Type “E”; Enter (maybe) (if a weird page come up)
- 12) Edit constitution in VIM
- 13) Hit “esc” to get out of type/delete words mode
- 14) Type “:wq”; Enter
  - a) Or, type “:q!”; Enter to quit without saving

#### **TERMINAL:**

“CD” - travel to the thing

“CD ..” - go back one (to higher-up folder\_)

“LS” - list

“CP” - copy

#### **VIM:**

“Ul” - unordered list

“Li” - list item

Move through document with arrow keys

Hit “i” to type/delete words

Hit “esc” to get out of type/delete words mode

Hit “\$” to go to the end of a line

#### **FOR BYLAWS:**

Do the same as above, but skip 9), and for 10) type “bylaws.php”

#### **FOR “HIDDEN” BYLAWS:**

Do the same as above, but skip 9), and for 10) type “bylaws\_full/bylaws.php”

## **The Easier Way**

1. Install Fetch (not every time)
2. Hostname “athena.dialup.mit.edu”; username + password is kerberos; connect with “SFTP”
3. Click “path” and select “athena.mit.edu”
4. Click “activity”
5. Click “e”
6. Click “ensemble”
7. Click “web\_scripts”
8. Click “about”
9. Download/”get” the current constitution version
10. Rename and upload to folder “Old Constitutions”
11. Update constitution document in TextEdit
12. Upload a constitution.php to replace the old constitution.php file
