OPENING SCREEN



- GOOD (L): The create account and forgot password links are in blue and are underlined (external consistency)
- GOOD: Very little to distract the user from the intended task of logging in (minimalist design)
- GOOD (S): There is the option of retrieving a forgotten password (safety, recovery)

PROBLEMS:

 MINOR (L): There is no byline or statement of purpose for the website so a first time user unfamiliar with Donate2Us wouldn't know what the website is for (learnability, documentation)

FIRST SCREEN UPON LOGIN




• GOOD (S): The top bar has direct links to all of the pages for each task (user control & freedom)

PROBLEMS:

- MAJOR (L): There is no content displayed upon entry which could confuse the user who might not know what to do first (feedback, minimalist design)
- MAJOR (L): The black border extends off the bottom and right side which implies the ability to scroll in those directions but in reality you can only scroll down (external consistency & standards, aesthetics)

SEARCHING FROM MAIN SCREEN



• GOOD (S): The search bar becomes highlighted in blue when you click on it (visibility of system status, feedback)

PROBLEMS:

- MINOR (E): When you click on the search bar to type, it does not automatically highlight the "Search for a cause to join..." so when you type that text is not automatically erased (efficiency)
- COSMETIC: There is no white space between the search text entry and the search button (aesthetics)

DESCRIPTION OF CAUSE FROM SEARCH RESULTS



 GOOD: The name of the cause is centered and displayed clearly along with a corresponding image (minimalist design & aesthetics)

PROBLEMS:

- MINOR: The back to search results button partially covers up the Donate2Us title (aesthetics, visibility)
- MAJOR: The view only scrolls down even though the border and text get cut off on the right as well as the bottom (external consistency, aesthetics, visibility)

DONATION PAGE




 GOOD: The name of the cause and corresponding image are still displayed as well as DONATE being displayed boldly (minimalist design & aesthetics)

PROBLEMS:

- COSMETIC: The message text box is larger than the border for the form (aesthetics)
- COSMETIC: The amount box might be too small for large donations, could just make it longer (aesthetics)

SHARE PAGE




 GOOD (S): Colored tabs clearly show what type of sharing is selected and allow user to easily switch (user control & freedom, visibility of system status)

PROBLEMS:

 COSMETIC: The text boxes touch the border of the form, there should be some white space (aesthetics)


POST ACTIVITY COMPLETION MAIN PAGE



PROBLEMS:

• MINOR: The links to the causes are cut in half images rather than whole images (aesthetics)

ACCOUNT PAGE




• GOOD (S): The fields for credit card number and CVV show stars to hide private information (safety, external consistency)

PROBLEMS:

 COSMETIC (S): The cancel and save buttons look the same and are nearby so users might press one or the other by accident (error prevention)

CAUSE INFORMATION PAGE




 GOOD (L): dropdown arrow affordance (external consistency)

PROBLEMS:

 MINOR: The category dropdown should have other be an option as well (consistency & standards, user control)

FORGOT PASSWORD PAGE



PROBLEMS:

- MINOR: Forgot Password forms usually only require the username or email, not both, since they will send the password to the email associated with the username (external consistency)
- COSMETIC (L): The reset password button has a back arrow which is slightly confusing since it isn't a back button, it is just a submit button (external consistency)
