

- 1. Design is simple and minimal (Aesthetic and minimalist design) [Good]
- 2. No visibility of whose account this is, as in there is not indication, no feedback, as to which user this profile belongs to. (S, Visibility and System Status) [Major]
- 3. The position of the +New Timer button is easily accessible. The purpose of the site is to track timers and thus having the major feature in a corner is in a very handy position. [Good]
- 4. However, even though position-wise it's good, it's very subtle in terms of look; it blurs with the background. Tradeoff: entire website aesthetics vs. efficiency in finding it. (S, recognition not recall) [Cosmetic]



- 5. The format of time is not indicated in any way in the "New Timer" form. 24 hr, 12 hr w/ am pm. Filling a new event, the time format is supposed to be written is not specified, and there are no cues to help. (L, help and documentation, E, Efficiency and flexibility) [Major]
- 6. No logical ordering for the alarms. I am expecting urgent ones to be on top of the list, and as they're farther away in time they are on the bottom of the list. This can lead to user confusion. (L, Match the real world, S, error prevention) [Catastrophic]



7. Invite information is scarce; the user requires more information before he adds the timer to his timers. To add an invite, I don't want to know the title; I want to know the time and the title and who invited me before I add it. A mouse can go over it and a bubble appears with info. (L, match the real world, E, flexibility and efficiency) [Major]



8. The UNTIL describes what? The timer is counting in time measurement, and UNTIL points to a date. It should point to the event not the day, technically the day starts at 00:00. (L, consistency and standards) [Minor]



9. To add a new timer, the timer form the order doesn't make sense, I would want to put the title, before I put time and date. Maybe change "New Alarm" to a refillable field. Like Google docs when you create a new doc, it has it as "untitled" and it's highlighted to indicate that you can rename it. (L, consistency) [Major]



- 10. An event needs a title, a time and a venue. (WHAT? WHEN? WHERE?). A location would be a good feature to add, maybe an end time as well (an end time can be an optional feature depending on what the timer is used for) (L, consistency and standards, match the real world) [Major]
- 11. The event name is smaller in font size than the timer, that gives more importance to the timer, and it diverts attention from the name of the event, which is more important, because that's what people usually look for first. (L, consistency and standards, E, efficiency and flexibility)[Minor]


12. Position of (Edit/Share Delete) should be aligned on the right to allow the positions the (Edit/..Delete) button to be consistent among all timers and externally with other websites. i.e. when the user want to delete an entry, the position of delete is the same regardless of how long the title is. (E, Efficiency and Flexibility, L, Consistency and Standards) [Major]




- 13. Visual cue when hovering over an invite or an alarm for that matter. Give feedback that the cursor is there. (L, Help and Documentation) [Minor]
- 14. There is no distinction between events that are in the past and those that are happening in less than a day (red), other than negative signs in front of the counter. The negative signs are not sufficient, it's confusing and not efficient, it requires me to do math to know whether or not it's in the past. Maybe at

least a different color for events in the past, or an automatic delete. This would be a big problem in efficiency especially in the case where there is a lot of passed events, they make a lot of clutter and the user will need to scroll down a lot to find an event that's in the future. (E, flexibility and efficiency, L, Help and Documentation) [Catastrophic]

- 15. On that note, the user should be given feedback to indicate that an event is happening right now (consistency with facebook). (L, consistency and standards, Feedback) [Major]
- 16. Auto complete for adding more than one person. It works for the first person but not the rest, also how do I know what to separate the persons I invite with (E, flexibility and efficiency) [minor]



17. Good documentation on tutorial page to describe color-coding. (L, help and documentation) [Good]



18. Help and documentation is no longer available after the tutorial page. A new user can forget what yellow is. A suggestion would be to keep the explanation and every time a new event expiring in less than a day is added, it's placed under the red, and likewise for the yellow and blue. Until the user decides that he has learned the color references, and then he can remove it himself. (L, help and documentation) [Minor]

On that note, the transition from the tutorial page to the user page is not smooth. And there is no documentation for blue.

19. There is a misalignment of the time components and UNTIL between one event and the other. (L, consistency and standards) [Cosmetic]
