


Relevant Heuristic: Severity: Minor

The three buttons "View Your Budget", "Enter an Expense", and "Share_Budget" zoom directly to their corresponding locations when pressed. It was incredibly disorienting the first time I pressed these buttons – they just provided feedback too rapidly.




Relevant Heuristic: Severity: Major

When you hold the android device sideways on the Home page, the "Share_Budget" button gets cut off, as well as everything underneath it. Trying to scroll down to reach the other information produces no result in this state.



Relevant Heuristic: Severity: Minor

The pencil button next to "Total: 100 per month" is very small and hard to press. Also, it is unclear exactly what pressing that button will achieve.

Again, while holding the android device sideways, part of the login screen gets cut off. Users cannot see the "Forgot your username or password?" line in this state.




Relevant Heuristic: Severity: Minor


I have no idea what the little "-" button does that is next to the "category" input location. Pressing it does absolutely nothing, and there is no indication of what it should actually do.



Relevant Heuristic: Severity: Major


While holding the android device sideways, it is almost impossible to read the pie graph that is found in the View window.

While holding the android device sideways, the scroll area in the "Food Books Clothing" location becomes incredibly narrow, and it is almost impossible to scroll up and down to view all of your categories.

The font here is small, dense, and the headers are undistinguishable from the actual information. It is very hard to extract useful data at a glance.


Severity: Minor
