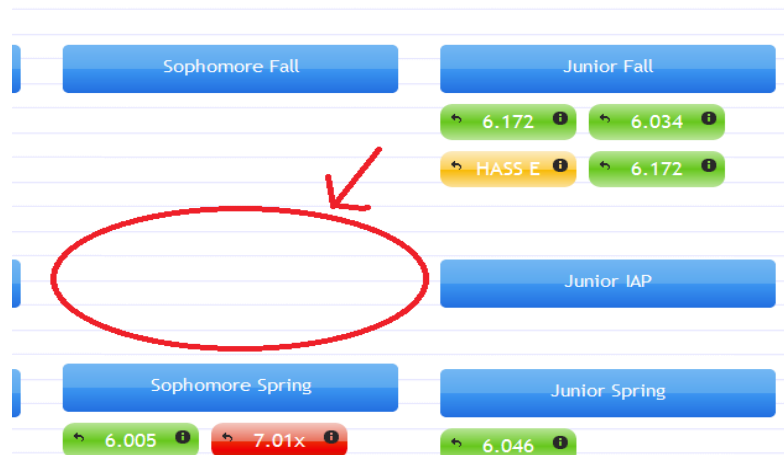

Prob 1: Deleted IAP marker



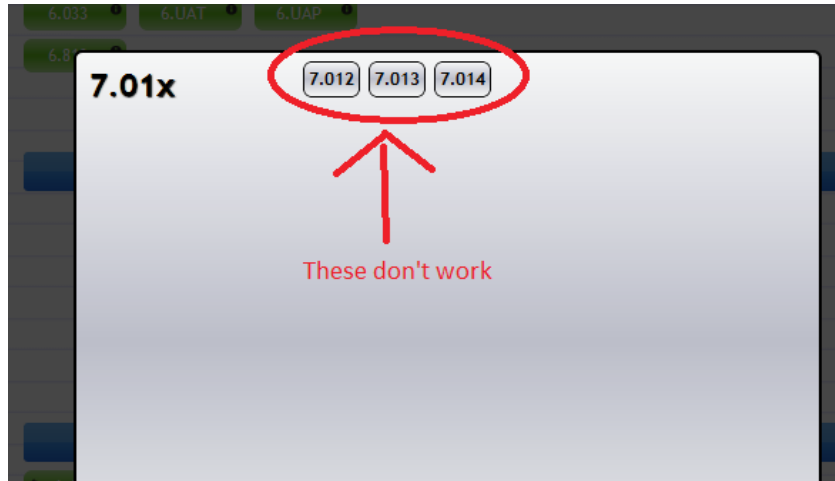
- Makes it impossible to put classes in Sophomore IAP term

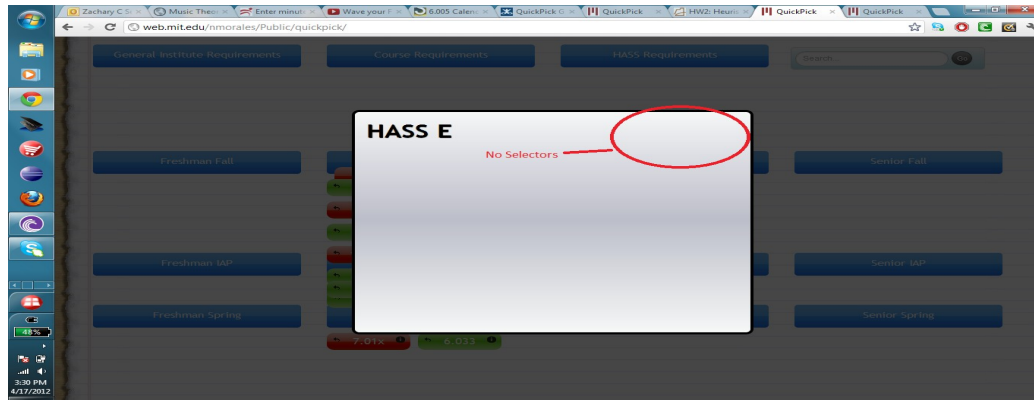
Prob 1: Would like to be able to drag classes back to course requirements area.



*Picture shows 6.01 panning back to Junior Fall after trying to drag to Course Requirements

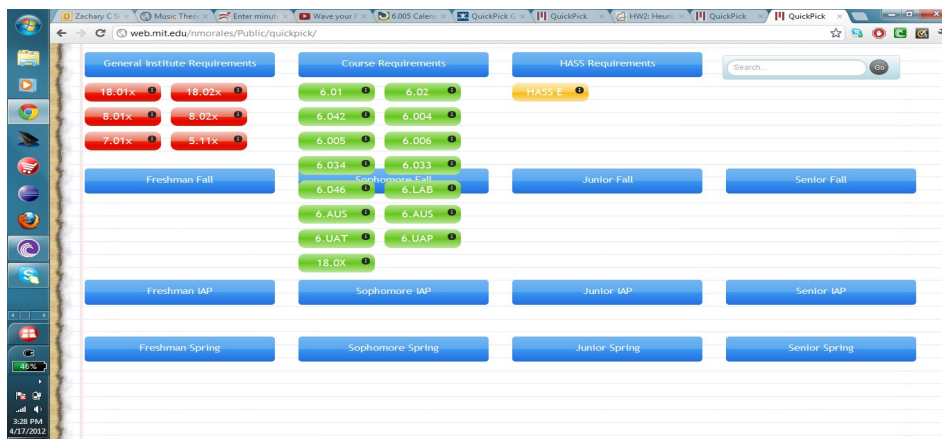

Prob 3: Zoom in (may not be fixable or worth it)



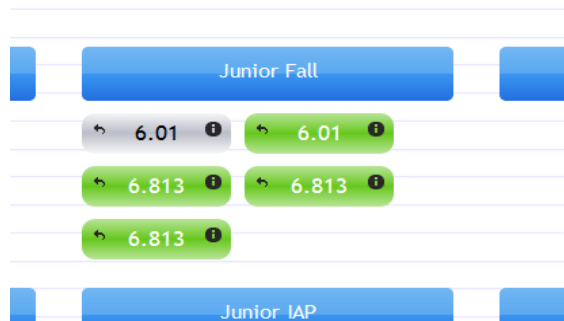

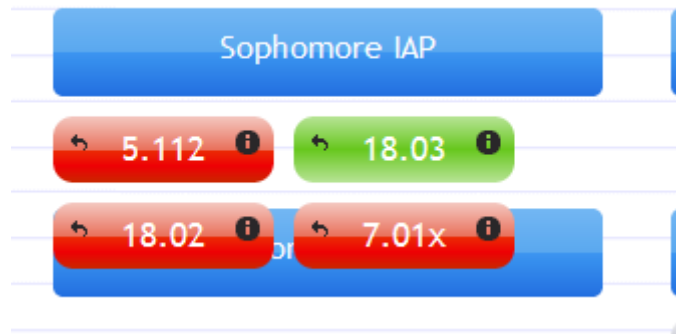
- Basic Idea is that it would be really nice to know what pre-recs are required for a class and whether or not you have satisfied them.

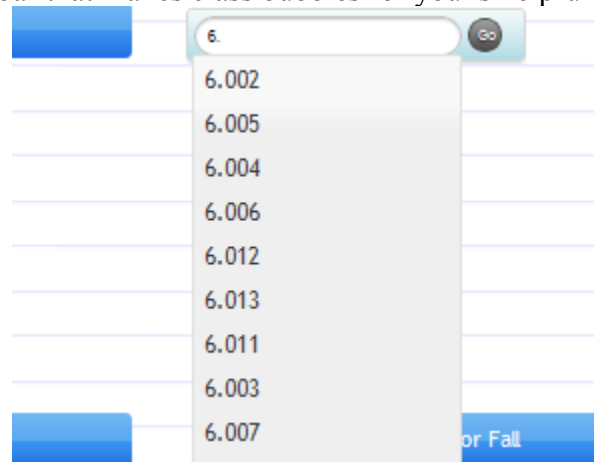
