
HW2: CollabDesk

1. **Positive feature:** The name and picture of the current user is shown in the right hand corner of the page. This helps to ensure that users are logged in correctly into their own accounts.

Type: Feedback

2. **Problem:** When a user performs a search and then clear the search bar, the window is not refreshed to the original view with all the messages organized based on date and read/unread statuses.




4. **Problem:** There's inconsistency with the logged in user and the name on a posted comment. Even though I'm logged in as Sally, when I post a comment, it says Julie.

Severity: catastrophic


5. **Problem:** Clicking on the search button without entering a keyword changes the display of the messages. The screenshot below is the result of clicking on the search button without query words.



Type: user control & freedom




Type: error prevention Severity: major

Type: affordances Severity: minor


8. **Problem:** The help message on "Alert Captain" is cut-off. Its intended message is "Automatically email this to the Desk Captain."




Type: help and documentation

9. **Problem:** When choosing to send a "Missing Package" message, it's not clear that there's other pre-filled text.




This is the default view, which makes it unclear that there's other information to be filled as shown in the next screenshot. One way to solve this problem is to make the default text box bigger.





10. **Problem:** Messages are defaulted to "High Priority" and "Alert Captain" even though those options are not chosen.




The image above clearly shows that "high priority" and "alert caption" options are not chosen. However, in the resulting entry, the icons on the top right indicate that they have.




Type: user control & freedom


This screenshot shows the message that I submitted. Below is the resulting message in the system, stating that it's "undefined."


Severity: major

Type: match with the real world



15. **Problem:** When replying to a message, the user is still able to toggle between "note" and "issue" regardless the status of the current message. However, a status change is not shown in the reply message. In the example below, I'm replying an "issue" message to a note. After submitting that issue, there's nowhere in the resulting message that shows that it was an "issue."



The resulting message doesn't say that the message submitted by Julie is an issue.

Type: consistency & standards

Severity: major

16. **Positive Feature:** When the cursor hovers over a message in the left panel, it block turns gray. It is a good use of color/affordances to warn user of the message that they are about to click on.
