

1. same colors shouldn't be used for different sitters (Fig.1)

Usability Heuristic: Consistency

Using green and purple backgrounds for multiple babysitters seems to falsely associate those with the same color.

2. Better color contrast (Fig. 1)

Usability Heuristic: Readability

Description: The black text on purple background is hard to read.

3. Difference on schedule between 'my jobs' and 'available jobs'? (Fig. 1)

Usability Heuristic: Track state

All of the jobs in both the "My Jobs" list and the "Available Jobs" lists are listed on this calendar with nothing distinguishing between the two groups.

4. column header text should be more distinct from other text in table (Fig. 2)

Usability Heuristic: Readability

Larger text will make these headers stand out more.

Usability Heuristic: Consistency

Columns line up to make it very quick to compare dates and times between families.

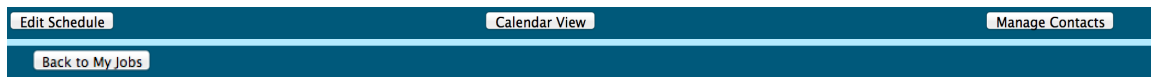

6. menu button sizes are too small (Fig. 3)

Usability Heuristic: Learnability

More visible menu options will better convey to the user where he should navigate.

7. Consistent Menu Needed (Fig. 3)

Usability Heuristic: Flexibility and Efficiency

Users should be able to do all menu bar actions from either screen. There is only a back button on the calendar view.

8. purpose of manage contacts button? (Fig. 3)

Usability Heuristic: Anticipation

This button title could better convey the purpose of the view it triggers.

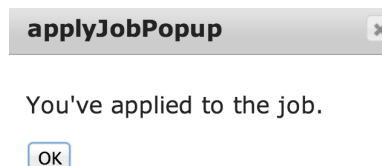


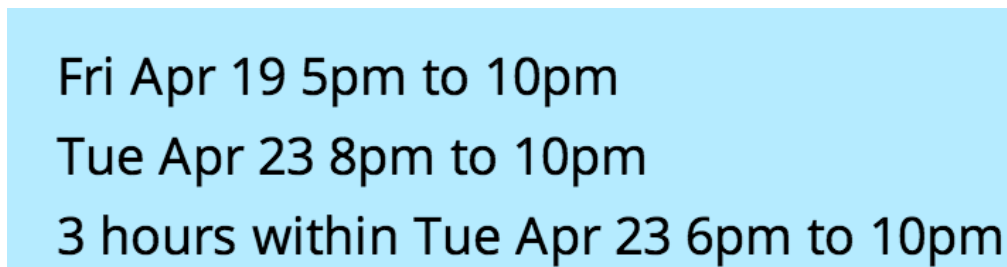

Usability Heuristic: Feedback

The title 'applyJobPopup' should be more descriptive, or removed.

14. Creation of job shouldn't be allowed with no times selected (Fig. 7)

Usability Heuristic: Error Prevention: Safety

This is not a valid job (where there is no time selected), so the user should not be able to progress to this screen.

15. More differentiation between hired and pending jobs (Fig. 8)

Usability Heuristic: Track State

It should be more clearly indicated the difference between hired jobs and pending jobs (either with or without applicants). Different row background colors, or different tables, possibly.
